

SHORT-TERM ASSIGNMENTS – Insurance Claims

BWS have undertaken a number of assignments on behalf of the insured party to collect, collate, present and negotiate recoverable costs with the Insurer's Loss Adjusters.

1) Insurance Claim Management

Client: Confidential.

Project: North Sea Oil Platform.

SoW Remedial work to a module support frame after damage caused by a craneage failure in the fabrication yard.

BWS SoW: To co-ordinate and agree the preparation of contracts, budgets and record keeping in respect of remedial work carried out by the main contractor, sub-contractors and other specialists.

Thereafter to prepare and present a dossier to the Loss Adjuster and justify all costs associated with the remedial work.

2) Insurance Claims Management

Client: Confidential.

Project: North Sea Oil Platform.

SoW Remedial work to 18,000 tonne jacket which was damaged during load-out onto ocean going barge at the fabrication yard.

Damage caused when breaking system failed allowing jacket to strike the barge superstructure damaging the jacket and the barge.

BWS SoW: To co-ordinate and agree the preparation of contracts, budgets and record keeping in respect of remedial work carried out by the main contractor, sub-contractors and other specialists.

Thereafter to prepare and present a dossier to the Loss Adjuster and justify all costs associated with the remedial work.

3) Insurance Claims Management

Client: Confidential.

Project: North Sea Oil Platform.

SoW Remedial work to offshore jacket during insitu installation of riser tubes.

Damage caused to jacket tubulars as a result of rigging failure and subsequent impact caused by falling riser.

BWS SoW: To co-ordinate and agree the preparation of contracts, budgets and record keeping in respect of remedial work carried out by the main contractor, sub-contractors and other specialists.

Thereafter to prepare and present a dossier to the Loss Adjuster and justify all costs associated with the remedial work.

4) Insurance Claims Management

Client: Confidential.

Project: Offshore Pipeline Installation (South America).

SoW Remedial work to offshore pipeline damaged during installation by lay-barge (i.e. buckling). Required a subsea repair and reconnection.

BWS SoW: To co-ordinate and agree the preparation of contracts, budgets and record keeping in respect of remedial work carried out by the main contractor, sub-contractors and other specialists. To gather information relating to the cause of the damage, capturing all the costs associated with the repair. Thereafter to prepare and present a dossier to the Loss Adjuster and justify all costs associated with the remedial work. Subsequently orchestrating the recovery of the various payments from many underwriters.
